TO RECONNECT WITH GOD I MUST

I. SEARCH FOR GODS

“Those who know your name trust in you, for you, O Lord, do not abandon those who search for you.” // **Psalms 9:10**

“Look up into the heavens. Who created all the stars? He brings them out like an army, one after another, calling each by its name. Because of his great power and incomparable strength, not a single one is missing. O Jacob, how can you say the Lord does not see your troubles? O Israel, how can you say God ignores your rights?” // **Isaiah 40:26-27**

“In the distant future, when you are suffering all these things, you will finally return to the Lord your God and listen to what he tells you. II. SEARCH FOR GODS

“That night the LORD appeared to Solomon in a dream, and God said, ‘What do you want? Ask, and I will give it to you!’ Solomon replied, ‘... Give me an understanding mind so that I can govern your people well and know the difference between right and wrong ...’ The Lord was pleased with Solomon’s reply and was glad that he had asked for wisdom.” // **1 Kings 3:5-6, 9 -10**
